



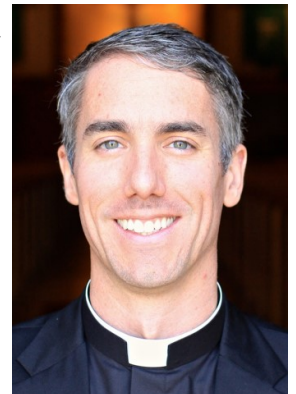
Get to know St. Teresa of Calcutta like never before

† **October 15 in the North Lake Church—Rev. John Burns** is a priest of the Archdiocese of Milwaukee. Ordained a priest in 2010, he has served as an associate pastor and pastor in Milwaukee as well as an adjunct professor of moral theology at the Sacred Heart Seminary and School of Theology. He works extensively with the Sisters of Life and Mother Teresa’s sisters, the Missionaries of Charity. *



† **October 22 in the North Lake Church—Mother Mary Catherine** was a Missionary of Charity for almost ten years while living in New York. When Mother Teresa visited there, Mother Mary Catherine would often be her driver. Mother Mary Catherine was sent home just before her final vows due to health reasons. After much discernment, she formed a new community, Missionaries of the Word, based in Baileys Harbor, Wisconsin.*
